A unique and special new trophy in memory of Mark, very kindly presented by David Biles, was on offer to the purchaser of the 'Gilten' Beast which this year was a superb Black Limousin x Steer from Mick Denness which sold for a market record price of 330p per kilo to long time show supporter Andy Gustar of Hamilton Fine Foods, who will now have the trophy to display in his window for the year.

Mick Denness had a fantastic day winning all the younger cattle classes and the lambs with son Richard having a very busy day as well handling the cattle.

Mick's Reserve Champion Heifer sold to 300p per kilo to Will Newman, P C Turner, Farnborough who also bought the Champion Lambs for £100.

There was great support throughout all the classes including the store cattle and a full list of all the winners and purchasers follows.

Our thanks go to our very experienced Judge Arthur Harriott and to the High Sheriff Susie Sheldon who gilded the Champion and stayed throughout the day showing a great interest in proceedings.

A special thank you to Matt Legge and his staff for continuing to make Brickfields available for the day and for all the hard work in erecting and dismantling the pens and in between performing every role from vendor to buyer, to ringman to bio security officer!
