Trevor Adams suckler bred Continentals born Aug/Nov 2010 saw the steers flying to £900 and the heifers £646 with other similar very tidy types from Jo House and Philip Harrison. Native breed sucklers were topped by a pretty bunch of yearlings Angus heifers from Mark and Amanda Farwell which met a very pleasing £550.

Dairy bred Continentals from Andrew Gale and Tony, Fiona and Ed Mogridge took the eye to top at £840 March 10. At 2 y.o. there were super entries from Dave Buttress and Lord William Edwards which really took the eye and some really spirited bidding took place pushing the steers to £1095 and heifers to £1045.
